- Supervisory Experience Preferred
- Bachelor's Degree must have been obtained between November 2007-January 2009

Click "Apply For MAP", completely fill out the application, and submit. (Application requires a ten year work history with names, dates, addresses and phone numbers-prepare ahead to complete quickly.)
2. Submit your Resume online by emailing your resume as an attachment to Employment@mgmmirage.com with the subject line "MAP-Resume" and indicate your Area of Interest (Hotel, F&B, etc...). (Remember to include your current GPA and scheduled graduation date on your resume.)
3. If your application is approved, you will receive a Pre-Screening Telephone Interview call from the College Relations team within a week of Applying Online and submitting your Resume. If you are selected to move on to the next step in the application process, we will require you to complete your application packet by mailing in your Official Transcripts, Career Essay and Letters of Recommendation (optional).
